Sunday Corporate Worship

Every Sunday morning we, as Christians, assemble for cooperate worship.

ENSURES COMPLETION OF BIBLICAL MANDATE: We are His body, His flock, a building, and a holy nation. All biblical metaphors for a church are plural. In Hebrews 10:24-25, we are advised to avoid relinquishing our meeting together. In this passage, people were under the threat of persecution. Simply meeting together could have led to their abuse. The benefits and value of meeting together far outweighed any possible threat they would face.

The life of a Christian is group experience, forging together toward the mark. There are no *Lone Rangers* in biblical Christianity.

PROVIDES GOOD FOR and TO US: Collective church attendance provides oversight, protection, and blessings, crucial for spiritual health as a Christian. Corporate worship, centered on biblical proclamation, protects against a myriad of ever-present dangers we all face as believers in a fallen world – from heresy at the hands of false teachers to unnecessary despair that arises from false thinking. Our gathering together provides many blessings, such as fellowship, encouragement, and accountability.

Church attendance provides for us what is unavailable in solitary living and work.

ENABLES THE GIVING AND RECEIVING OF LOVE. We come together for worship and stir up one another to love and pursue good works. We remember the words of 1 John 3:14, “We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brothers.” In a God-ordained way, your presence and voice (even when off-key) encourages those around you to commune with the Lord.

We ought to remember this – the decisions we make to worship together in the same space and at the same time have consequences for us, our families, *and* the whole of the body of Christ.

Weekday Bible Study

Every Christian should attend Bible study. It is in our own best interest to study the scriptures.

ASSISTS WITH IDENTIFYING TRUTH: We have a responsibility to know truth and fight against error (Ephesians 4:14, 5:11; 1 John 4:1). We should be able to recognize false doctrine and maintain favor with God (2 Timothy 2:15-17). In many Bible study classes, passages studied can help combat error. Bible study helps Christians rightly handle the Word of truth.

ENABLES GROWTH: Spiritual growth is possible with a proper diet of God's Word (Hebrews 5:12-14). Every Christian who is concerned about growing will attend Bible study. Attending Bible study will further the study of the Word outside of our scheduled Bible study, adding to you more spiritual growth opportunities.

PAYS DIVIDENDS: Bible study is profitable. It is in our own best interest to study the scriptures. It is good for us spiritually to make an effort to attend Bible study and have the opportunity to search the scriptures as often as possible. Paul tells us that the scriptures are profitable (2 Timothy 3:16, 17). At any given Bible study, we can profit.

PRODUCES A MAGNITUDE OF FAITH: Faith comes by hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17). The Word of God makes a person strong in the faith. Those who attend every service the church offers are likely the strongest and have the most faith.

Equip yourself with the Word of God. Attend Bible class and build up your faith.
